

# PANDEMIC EBT

Students in Arizona are eligible for Summer 2023 P-EBT if:

1) They are enrolled in May 2023 or the last month of the 2022-23 academic year in a participating National School Lunch Program (NSLP) site

**AND**

2) They are determined eligible for free or reduced-price meals by the last day of the 2022-23 academic year.

Households should make sure their school has the current mailing address on file.

Benefits = \$120 added to EBT card for use throughout the whole summer

Submit a free and reduced-price school meal application before the end of the school year to ensure your child receives P-EBT.

- Receive SNAP?
- OR**
- Attend a school with no-cost meals for all because of the Community Eligibility Provision?
  - Not sure? Ask your school.

Families who receive P-EBT can also participate in summer meals without impacting their benefits.

Benefits are provided on an EBT card:

- Received P-EBT before? Benefits are loaded onto the same card as before. If you lost this card, you can get it replaced.
- Receive SNAP? P-EBT benefits are loaded onto your SNAP card.
- New to P-EBT? A card will be mailed to you.

**Immigration status is not considered for Pandemic EBT eligibility and receiving P-EBT will not make you a public charge.**
